DEFINITIONS

Highmark Health Options (HHO) – Managed care organization serving vulnerable populations that have complex needs and qualify for Medicaid. Highmark Health Options members include individuals and families with low income, expecting mothers, children, and people with disabilities. Members pay nothing to very little for their health coverage. Highmark Health Options currently services Delaware Medicaid: Delaware Healthy Children Program (DHCP) and Diamond State Health Plan Plus members.

Subtalar arthroereisis – A treatment of adult or pediatric flatfoot which involves the insertion of an implant into the sinus tarsi, that acts as an internal orthotic or spacer. Placement of the implant restores the arch of the foot while preventing excessive pronation.
