Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA) federal and state mandated laboratory tests for preventive services are determined by the United States Preventive Services Task Force (USPSTF), American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) Bright Futures, Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) Women's Preventive Health, and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) General Immunization schedules.

- Labs performed for **preventive services** are for asymptomatic persons without a diagnosis of disease and include labs mandated by federal or state law.
- Labs performed for diagnostic services are for:
 - o symptomatic persons without a diagnosis of disease, or
 - monitoring patients with a diagnosis of disease
