Documentation Considerations

- Distinguish developmental versus intellectual disorders
- Classify the severity:
 - Mild
 - Moderate
 - Severe
- Document any cognitive, language/speech or physical impairments
- Link medications to the associated condition

Diagnosis Considerations

- Document and code any associated comorbidities
- Document and code any underlying genetic disorders
- Distinguish from other underlying brain disease (chemical-related, epilepsy, etc.)

Additional Considerations

- Document any care coordination/therapy
- Document efficacy of current therapy regimen
- Identify length of symptoms
- Document and code any additional psychological disorder(s)
