CHIP Update: No Assigned PCP Name on New Member ID Cards

Since October 2024, all new Highmark Healthy Kids CHIP* ID cards no longer include the assigned primary care physician (PCP) name on the front of the card. Newly enrolling CHIP members will receive a letter with their Highmark-assigned PCP practice. Highmark began assigning PCPs to newly enrolling CHIP members when we no longer received the PCP selections from the Pennsylvania Commonwealth System. CHIP members may contact Highmark to change their assigned PCP at any time.

Reimbursements for CHIP Preventive Health Schedule/Bright Futures services are made to any PCP performing services for an enrolled Highmark Healthy Kids CHIP HMO member. The member does not have to be assigned to the PCP for the practitioner to receive reimbursement.
